



Cooperation with parents

- Heimili og skóli (Eng. Home and School) is the national association of parents
- SAMFOK is the association of parents of school children in Reykjavík
- These associations support the cooperation with parents, and parents can get counselling there
- The service is free of charge





Cooperation with parents

- According to the Icelandic law, all schools are obliged to have an active parents association
- All parents who have children in the school are automatically members of a parent association
- Most parent associations charge an annual fee but the payment is optional

- Parent meeting twice a year
- Parental agreement
- Class evenings twice a year
- Parent walk

School and class atmosphere

How can parents aim at a good school and class atmosphere?

- Show interest in school attendance of your child
 - Ask how the day was – what was done at school – what was for lunch?
- Get acquainted with other parents in the class and know other children in the class by name



School and class atmosphere



- Attend parent meetings in the class
 - Outdoor hours – birthday invitations – parties – usage of phones in the schools – social media – use of computers
- Attend class evenings
- Volunteer for parental work or individual projects within parental work



What is good to bear in mind?



- Birthdays in the class
 - Invitations – presents - attendance
- Fundraising for school trips of older children
- Information flow – Mentor – Facebook-groups
- Ask for help
